- (ii) Gross profit for 1Q 2016 decreased mainly due to lower contribution from rig building projects. However, gross profit for the offshore platforms projects was higher.
- (iii) Depreciation and amortisation for 1Q 2016 increased mainly due to depreciation charge for Tuas Boulevard yard and Brazil new yard.

#### 4c. Explanatory notes to Balance Sheets

#### (i) Group

#### Non-current assets

'Other financial assets' decreased mainly due to fair value adjustments of quoted equity shares and foreign currency forward contracts.

'Intangible assets' increased mainly due to acquisition of Gravifloat AS in March 2016.

'Deferred tax assets' decreased mainly due to utilisation of unabsorbed tax losses.

#### **Current assets**

'Inventories and work-in-progress' comprising mainly work-in-progress decreased due to the successful delivery of a rig building project. The recoverability of work-in-progress from the rig building segment is dependent on the customers taking delivery of the rigs in the future.

'Trade and other receivables' increased mainly due to billings for ongoing projects and timing of receipts.

'Tax recoverable' increased mainly due to payment made during the period.

'Other financial assets' decreased mainly due to fair value adjustments on foreign currency forward contracts.

'Cash and cash equivalents' increased mainly due to proceeds from borrowings.

#### **Current liabilities**

'Trade and other payables' decreased mainly due to timing of payments made during the period.

'Excess of progress billings over work-in-progress' increased mainly due to billing to a customer for offshore platforms project.

'Provisions' decreased mainly due to write back of allowance made for warranty provision.

'Other financial liabilities' decreased mainly due to fair value adjustments on foreign currency forward contracts.

'Current tax payable' increased mainly due to current year tax provision, offset by payments made during the period.

'Interest-bearing borrowings' decreased mainly due to refinancing of short term borrowings to long term borrowings. The Group has secured adequate committed long term banking facilities to refinance the short term borrowings as they fall due.

#### 4c. Explanatory notes to Balance Sheets (Cont'd)

#### (i) Group (Cont'd)

#### **Non-current liabilities**

'Deferred tax liabilities' increased mainly due to tax effects of fair value adjustments on foreign currency forward contracts and movement in temporary differences.

'Other financial liabilities' decreased mainly due to fair value adjustments on foreign currency forward contracts.

'Interest-bearing borrowings' increased mainly due to borrowings for working capital and capital expenditures, and refinancing of short term borrowings to long term borrowings.

#### **Equity**

'Other reserves' deficit mainly due to fair value adjustments on quoted prices of available-for-sale financial assets, lower foreign currency translation gain for foreign operations, offset by fair value adjustments on foreign currency forward contracts.

'Non-controlling interests' increased mainly due to acquisition of subsidiary (Gravifloat AS) with non-controlling interests.

#### (ii) Company

#### **Non-current assets**

'Investments in subsidiaries' increased mainly due to the acquisition of Gravifloat AS.

'Other financial assets' decreased mainly due to fair value adjustments of quoted equity shares, and deemed disposal of other financial asset arising from the Group's step-up acquisition of Gravifloat AS from 12% to 56% in March 2016.

#### **Current assets**

'Cash and cash equivalents' increased mainly due to dividends received from subsidiaries.

#### **Current liabilities**

'Trade and other payables' increased mainly due to timing of payments made during the period.

#### **Non-current liabilities**

'Other long-term payables' decreased mainly due to lower long-term employee benefits.

#### **Equity**

'Other reserves' deficit increased mainly due to fair value adjustments on quoted prices of available-for-sale financial assets.

#### 5c. Explanatory notes to Consolidated Statement of Cash Flows

#### First quarter

Cash flows from operating activities before changes in working capital was \$84.0 million in 1Q 2016. Net cash used in operating activities for 1Q 2016 at \$72.9 million was mainly due to working capital for the ongoing rig building projects.

Net cash used in investing activities for 1Q 2016 was \$148.8 million. The Group spent \$102.1 million on expansion and operational capital expenditures, mainly for the Brazil new yard and Phase II of Sembmarine Integrated Yard @ Tuas.

Net cash generated from financing activities for 1Q 2016 was \$572.4 million. It relates mainly to net proceeds from borrowings.

As at 31 March 2016, there were 973,312 (31 March 2015: 1,676,502) unissued ordinary shares under options granted to eligible employees and directors under the Company's Share Option Plan ("SOP").

#### (iii) Performance Shares

In 1Q 2016, there were 605,000 (1Q 2015: 675,000) performance shares that lapsed under the Company's Performance Share Plan ("PSP") due to the under achievement of performance targets.

The total number of performance shares in awards granted conditionally and representing 100% of targets to be achieved, but not released as at 31 March 2016 was 2,595,000 (31 March 2015: 2,135,000). Based on the multiplying factor, the actual release of the awards could range from zero to a maximum of 3,892,500 (31 March 2015: 3,202,500) performance shares.

#### (iv) Restricted Shares

During 1Q 2016, 2,072,713 (1Q 2015: 2,821,760) restricted shares were released under the Company's Restricted Share Plan ("RSP") and 145,891 (1Q 2015: 101,647) restricted shares lapsed. The restricted shares released were settled by way of issuance of treasury shares.

In 1Q 2016, there were 1,471,967 restricted shares that lapsed due to the under achievement of performance targets (1Q 2015: 198,159 restricted shares awarded for the over-achievement of the performance targets).

Turnover for 1Q 2016 decreased mainly due to the lower revenue recognition for rig building projects resulting from customer deferment requests and customer's restructuring. For the offshore platforms projects, turnover was higher in 1Q 2016.

#### (ii) Profit attributable to Owners of the Company ("Net profit")

Net profit for 1Q 2016 decreased mainly due to lower contribution from rig building projects resulting from customer deferment requests and restructuring, and higher finance costs.

#### 12. VARIANCE FROM PROSPECT STATEMENT

There is no material change from the previous prospect statement.

#### 13. PROSPECTS

The offshore oil and gas exploration industry is now into its second year of weak prices and capex cuts following the collapse of oil prices in mid 2014. Offshore rig charter contracts continue to be negotiated at lower levels and utilisation is on a downtrend for all segments.

The global oil and gas industry continues to be volatile and uncertain with the April OPEC and non-OPEC producers meeting in Doha failing to reach an agreement for a production freeze.

On 20 April 2016, shareholders of Sete Brazil agreed to a plan to file for judicial recovery. Meanwhile the political upheaval in Brazil continues with the process to impeach its current president.

Sembcorp Marine believes this down-cycle is likely to be more protracted than previous cycles. Whilst maintaining its cautious outlook, the Group is prepared not just to overcome these challenges but to lay stronger foundations for the future when the market recovers.

The Group will continue to actively manage its balance sheet. It remains optimistic of the longer term prospects of its business with facilities being built to cater to the Industry's demand for the long term. As an integrated Sembcorp Marine, we will optimise our capabilities and capacities as well as increase our efficiency and productivity to better serve our partners and customers.

#### (i) Business segments

The Group has two reportable segments, which are the Group's strategic business units. The strategic business units are managed separately because of their different business activities. The two reportable segments are (i) rigs & floaters, repairs & upgrades, offshore platforms and specialised shipbuilding (ii) ship chartering.

Inter-segment sales and transfers are carried out on an arm's length basis. Segment assets consist primarily of property, plant and equipment, current assets and exclude inter-segment balances. Segment liabilities comprise mainly operating liabilities and exclude inter-segment balances. Performance is measured based on segment profit before income tax, as included in the internal management reports that are reviewed by the Group's CEO. Segment profit is used to measure performance as management believes that such information is the most relevant in evaluating the results of certain segments relative to other entities that operate within these industries.

Other operations include bulk trading in marine engineering related products; provision of harbour tug services to port users; collection and treatment of used copper slag, and the processing and distribution of copper slag for blast cleaning purposes.

#### (ii) Geographical segments

The Group operates principally in the Republic of Singapore. In presenting information on the basis of geographical segments, segment revenue is based on the geographical location of customers. Segment assets and total assets are based on the geographical location of the assets.
